Path to Youth Reengagement Program:

- Oregon Student Success Act 2019
 - ODE est. Youth Development Division
 - Funds allocated to YDD from SSA
 - YDD Grants made available for regional programs
 - CFSS awarded grant for Youth Reengagement Pgm
 - Funding cycle through June 2021





What does the Youth Reengagement Program Do?

- Tutoring
- Mentoring
- Connecting youth with wrap-around services



GOALS OF THE PROGRAM...

Reengage youth to:

- Earn missing credits
- Achieve GED or Diploma
- Receive vocational training <or>
 internships/job shadowing experience



HOW WILL THIS BE DONE?



- Delivering support for academic challenges
- Building connections to community services
- Linking youth to workforce development
- Linking youth to higher ed opportunities
- Regular coaching and mentoring
- Regular meetings with youth via F2F or virtual

Program Coach will conduct pre- and postassessments to determine needs, develop individual reengagement plan, and provide "SMART Goal Setting" work with youth.



FAQs...

How are youth referred to program?

Schools and other community organizations can refer.

What is the criteria?

- 14 to 21
 - Does not have GED or Diploma AND not enrolled
 - Defined as "dropout" per ORS 339.505 AND not exempt
 - Referred by OYS, DHS, Court, JDH, Tribes, SD/ESD
- 16 to 21
 - Enrolled 1+ yrs prior AND 3 or more credits deficient

Will parent/guardian be contacted?

Yes, unless youth is 18 or older - then on case by case basis.



What is the process?

1. Referral Packets...

Given to schools/agencies.

2. Youth/Parent is counseled...

By school or community agency and offered opportunity to participate in program.

3. Forms to be completed for referral...

"ROI" AND "Referral Form" is completed by school or agency and sent to Citizens for Safe Schools

4. Program Coach...

Contacts Youth/Parent and conducts intake.
